What Is Liposuction?

Liposuction Birmingham like liposuction all over the world is commonly defined as the removal of excess fatty tissue that accumulates just deep to the skin with the use of a cannula (a stainless steel tube). The use of a powerful suction pump is also employed in the process to suck out the fat and this surgical procedure can be performed under either local or general anesthesia. The popularity of liposuction Birmingham can be explained by the fact that it is safe, has a high success rate and gives great cosmetic results. Liposuction Birmingham typically progresses in the following distinct stages.

Surgeon Search

Once you have decided to go ahead with the surgery you will begin searching for a surgeon in your area. It is recommended that you to take your time in finding a surgeon who is skilled, experienced, practices at a respected health care facility and does not demand a fee that is too high. There are numerous websites online that allow you to make specific searches in relation to liposuction Birmingham so that you can easily find exactly what you are looking for without any problem at

all.

Consultations

Some people rate this stage of the process as the most important because it is during this time that all important decisions regarding the procedure are made. These include the details of the areas that you would like to have treated, the results you wish you see, the type of anesthesia you wish to have administered and also how much the entire procedure will cost you. It is also a good time for you to familiarize yourself with the surgeon and details of the procedure. Body areas where liposuction can be performed and their costs are:

- Upper and lower abdomen -- \$3,000 to \$7,500
- Arms -- \$1500 to \$4,000
- Buttocks -- \$1,500 to \$4,500
- Breasts -- \$3,000 to \$7,500
- Chin, jowls, neck or cheeks -- \$2,000 to \$4,500
- Flanks -- \$2,000 to \$5,000
- Knees and inner thighs -- \$2,000 to \$5,000
- Knees and anterior thighs -- \$2,000 to \$5,000
- Outer thighs -- \$1,600 to \$5,000
- Hips or waist -- \$1,600 to \$5,000

The Surgery

This stage begins with pre-op preparation, incision marking and the administration of local or general anesthesia after which the actual surgery begins. The surgeon will first make very small incisions through which he will insert the cannula and pull out the excess fat using the power of the suction pump attached to the cannula. The procedure ends with stitching closed and bandaging of the incision wounds.

Post-op

The period of time that you will have to stay in the health care facility under observation depends on the extent of your surgery. During this time your vitals will be closely monitored, you will be given medications to erase any pain and the bandages over the incisions will be regularly changed. You will also be briefed on how to care for the wounds on your own before you are discharged.
